CALL TO ARTISTS

Title: **YOUR EVERY DAY HERO/SHERO**

Community Arts of Bellevue, a member of the Bellevue 9/11 Twentieth Anniversary Memorial Committee, invites submissions for a juried art exhibition. Cash prizes will be given to all winning entries in each category. Selected entries from each category will be on display throughout the 9/11 Memorial event and then will be moved back to the Bellevue Public Library for a public viewing event and artist reception (more details to follow).

The theme of this exhibit is **Your Every Day Hero/Shero**. This is an opportunity for you to depict someone or something that you would claim as your hero or shero every day. Just like the every day people that reacted without reservation the day of 9/11....simply because they had to do it, it's who they were/are.

Categories: Elementary, Middle School, High School, Adult (over 18)

All eligible (see below) artists are invited to participate

Jury will select 10 works from each category

1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category. (Prize for each winner)

1 - Overall Best In Show

Eligibility: Residents of the West Harpeth area (West Nashville, Pegram, Kingston Springs, Fairview)

Artwork Details:

Pieces are not to exceed 24"x30"

Pieces need to be on stretched canvas or matted if on paper

2D only (no sculptor)

All works must be ready to hang

Logistics:

All finished artworks are to be delivered to the **Bellevue Public Library** by 5:00 pm, August 31, 2021.

Judging Criteria:

— Score 1-5 in each criteria

- Creativity
- Craftsmanship
- Originality
- Supports the theme
- Presentation
